

Helen Bader Age & Community Scholarship Guidelines

Scholarship Descriptions:

Scholarships are for one year. You may reapply for a second year of support. We will accept applications from third year certificate students, but they will receive lowest priority in the review of applicants.

Nomination/Application Criteria:

A student must be nominated by a faculty member to apply for the scholarship award. The nominee/applicant must:

- Demonstrate a 3.0 or higher GPA for two consecutive academic years at the undergraduate level or one year at the graduate level
- Demonstrate a commitment to the field of gerontology
- Demonstrate leadership skills through participation in community service, research, extracurricular, and/or other activities
- Have the intention to complete the Graduate Certificate Program in Applied Gerontology at UW-Milwaukee

Nomination/Application process:

The applicant must submit:

- Two letters of recommendation; at least one to comment on your academic potential.
- An essay from the nominee/applicant that addresses his/her unique qualifications for receiving this award, including experience in and dedication to the field. (no more than 2 pages single spaced)
- Undergraduate transcripts and Graduate transcripts (if applicable)
- Applicants must contact a Center on Age and Community Scholar regarding their intent to apply for the scholarship. **Applications must have their application signed by the nominating Center Scholar.**

NOTE: For UWM students, unofficial transcripts are acceptable and available free of charge in Mellencamp Hall, Room 274.

Deadlines:

Applications must be in the Center office by **April 1st**

Awards will be announced on **April 8th**
