

CAC Travel Grants for Faculty and UWM Students 2007-08

CAC is offering travel grants to support UWM students and faculty who are making a presentation at a conference on a topic on aging.

Grants for Fall/Spring and Spring/Summer Travel Available

Two awards for \$750 each will be awarded in the Fall for Fall/Spring travel, and two in the Spring for Spring/Summer travel.

- Deadline for Fall submission: September 14, 2007 by 5:00 pm
- Notification of award for Fall/Spring travel: September 28, 2007
- Deadline for Spring submission is February 1, 2008 by 5:00 pm
- Notification of award for Spring/Summer travel: February 15, 2008

Eligibility

Student: Full-time, undergraduate student in good standing. Exceptions made only with faculty justification. Travel grants also open to graduate students. Conference presentations must be on a topic on aging.

Faculty: Any faculty member who is making a presentation on a topic on aging.

How to Apply

Submit a 1-paragraph request in which you provide the name, location, and dates of the conference you wish to attend, as well as the title of your talk, and all co-authors. Please provide one or two sentences describing the nature of the research to be presented. Include your name, the date, and your contact information (e-mail, address, and phone).
